REPORT ON THE DAILY BOAT TRAFFIC THROUGH THE NARROWS -- NEW YORK HARBOR 1937

In order to determine the relative amounts of the commercial traffic as compared with the pleasure craft traveling through The Narrows of New York Harbor, a count was made of the records kept by the United States Coast Guard Service. It was found that the records were available from June 1st to December 31st, 1937, and through the courtesy of Commander Baylis the Interstate Sanitation Commission was enabled to make use of this data.

This record is a complete record of the vessels entering or leaving New York Harbor through The Narrows. It was found that the record was very complete, the information including the nationality, the name and home port and the type of each vessel, together with information as to whether the vessel was in-bound or out-bound and the time of observation. The time was arranged on the twenty-four hour basis beginning at Midnight, the hours being recorded from 0 to 24.

It is understood that eight different boats are from time to time engaged in this service from the New London Harbor Base. As such a large number of boats and persons is used in obtaining the information, it is not surprising to find that there are some slight differences in the classification of the vessels. The information, however, gave entirely satisfactory data for obtaining the number of commercial vessels as distinguished from pleasure craft. For the purpose of this count, the following vessels were classified as pleasure boats: yachts, motor boats, cabin cruisers, fishing party boats and excursion boats. Possibly only the first three

of these classifications should be classed as pleasure craft due to the fact that the fishing party and excursion boats are engaged in the business of transporting people.

Sample sheets are given for the reports taken on July 3rd and October 27th, 1937, as Appendix II. The first of these is a count made on a busy holiday in which the number of pleasure craft would be heavier than usual, while the count for October 27th indicates the normal fall travel when pleasure craft would not be used in very great numbers. This count also is made for a day in the middle of the week.

It is apparent from a summation given in Table I, below, of the boats for December 2nd and 3rd, 1937, that in one case vessels are designated as "steamers", while in the other, they are referred to as "freighters." This difference is of no importance in our classification as determined by the count, as both are classed as commercial vessels.

A daily count and classification of the boats was made for the summer months of June, July and August including the seasons of the greatest boat traffic during the vacation season, and for comparison daily counts were made of November and December during a season when pleasure craft would not be used to any great extent. The results of this count are given for each day for the five months of June, July, August, November and December, 1937, in Appendix I. This data gives the number of boats classified as to whether they were commercial or pleasure craft, as well as the total number of boats listed.

The same information is condensed into tabular form in Table II, as follows: (See next page)

This table shows that the total count included 29,142 different vessels. The daily average number of vessels of each type for the months counted were as follows:

The average boat travel for the three summer months was 218 commercial vessels and 23 pleasure craft daily. It is to be noted that the number of pleasure craft was greatly increased on holidays and week-ends. For the two months of November and December, the average number of commercial vessels was 123 and of pleasure craft, 5.

As far as known, this is the most reliable and only data of a complete character classified by the types of boats which is at present available.
